

How to obtain non-owned insurance to Fly Time Aviation

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Overview & Purpose

This lesson will walk you through the Fly Time Aviation procedures for obtaining non-owned insurance to operate Fly Time Aviation aircraft.

Activity

- Non-owned insurance is a requirement to operate Fly Time Aviation aircraft. A minimum policy of \$25,000 is required.
- Shopping for the non-owned insurance is completely the renters responsibility.
 There are three reputable aviation insurance companies listed on flytimechd.com.
- 3. The incentive offered to offset the cost of a 12-month \$25,000 policy, which has been found to be less than \$340, is a credit of \$330. This credit can be used toward aircraft rental.
- 4. Please email a copy of the policy to flytime.billing@gmail.com.
- 5. To utilize the \$330 toward aircraft rental, notate in the comments section of the reservation that you wish to use the credit toward.
- 6. You can use up to \$110 of the credit toward aircraft rental each month.
- 7. You can use the credit over the course of your 12-month policy.
